1. Approve minutes of March 24, 2022:

### 2. Financial Status Report

- a. March net position decreased ~\$648k due to higher monthly claims; 5 weekly invoices were paid during March vs 4 invoices in Feb
- b. Claims up \$2.9m / 35% YOY.
- c. \$55k in credits received in March will be re-allocated to each member once we receive the breakout from USI.

## 3. Marketing – new members:

- a. ECHMC was represented at CASBO vendor day. East Hampton, Suffield, New Fairfield, Region 8 all expressed interest in exploring ECHMC. Westbrook, and Preston also expressed interest.
- **b.** EdAdvance shared their practice of adjudication process. Rich Carmelich shared a positive experience. Mike Belden will follow up with EdAdvance
- **c.** Holly McCalla will request the attorney review on the legality of a separated Goodwin Schools maintaining membership in ECHMC.

#### 4. Update from Vendors/Anthem Update

- a. USI Opt-In Plans for ECHMC. Tom will email full explanation of each option. Next meeting Board will vote on options.
  - i. Diabetic coverage 🐬
  - ii. Expands Birth to Three programs -extends the age
  - iii. Carriers explain benefits, and allow covered individuals to elect how the receive EOBs (no cost)
  - iv. Immunization Consultation (20 mins)
  - v. Psychotropic Drugs
  - vi. Utilization Management Review
  - vii. Dental/vision child and/or step child up to age 26 to mirror the medical.

New State Law: Insurers must issue healthcare card displaying status of insured or self-insured.

There is still a struggle from Anthem on large claim reports on a monthly basis.

Annual Renewal Rates: Since December the group is seeing a shift in claims surpassing payments. For consideration, our 8 million dollar in reserve. \$15,200,000. Projecting to bring in \$14,000,000.
